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# The skills of faculty members in Libyan universities in using social

networks to complete their studies during the Corona crisis: an

# exploratory study.

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### Abstract

This study aimed to know the ability and skill of the Libyan university professor to use social networks to complete the academic curricula and follow up his supervision of graduation projects during the Corona crisis by knowing the reality and nature of the use of the Libyan university faculty members for social networking sites such as Facebook applications, Twitter, WhatsApp and other applications. Which can be employed or used in distance education, and to find out the true purposes of the use of faculty members in Libyan universities for social networking sites, whether during or before the pandemic, while reaching the most important obstacles and challenges.

The study used the descriptive approach to achieve its objectives. The sample of the study consisted of faculty members in Libyan universities. The study excluded private universities, and their number reached 169 members. Among its most important results: Less than half of the sample were motivated to communicate with students to complete their curricula and graduation research during the quarantine

This caused, on the one hand, a clear inability of the faculty members to try to give lectures remotely and through social networks, and on the other hand, it led to a weakness in the technological skills of the faculty members, which caused their lack of desire to employ social networks at the time of the crisis, due to several factors. Difficulties that the study found some of them, as they came in high rates: such as the methods used in most Libyan university administrations, which are dominated by the traditional style.

And that the majority of the faculty members retreated at the time of the crisis, and did not tend to develop temporary solutions through social networks to complete their curricula and continue their lectures to advance the study at the time of the crisis, with the exception of some of them who were limited to using students to follow up their research and support them morally.

Therefore, the study recommended working to educate faculty members and students about the importance of employing social networking sites in the professional, teaching and research fields, and the need to give training courses in the field of activating social networks in the educational process for both students and faculty members, and the need for Libyan universities to work on activating social networks in University education, linking universities with each other and creating a social and educational communication base, working on the availability of good infrastructure, and removing all human material and technical challenges, that prevent the activation of social networks in the university educational process.
